So, get ready to have fun, try new things, and remember...learning at Hill View is an exciting adventure! We can't wait to see all the amazing things you'll achieve!

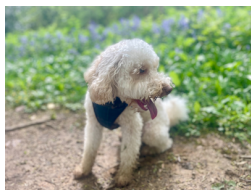

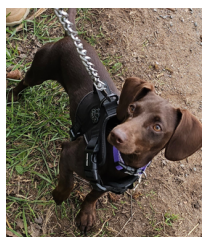


So who will you meet at Hill View School?

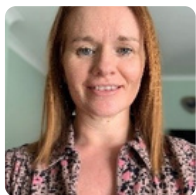

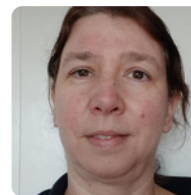

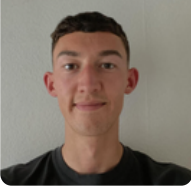

You probably have lot's of questions

Here are some of the questions that other learners have asked

Where can I eat lunch?

We have 2 separate rooms around school to eat your lunch. These rooms will be used by different year groups and our lunches are staggered. By doing this we can make sure that there is plenty of space to eat your lunch and the rooms don't become crowded. If you would prefer to eat your lunch in private, we can organise this very easily.

Will there be clubs?

We hope learners will come up with some great ideas to create clubs at lunchtime. Having clubs after school is slightly more difficult because a lot of our learners get transport home. If you have an idea for a club please share it with a member of staff.

Are there detentions at Hill View School?

At Hill View School, we don't have detentions. Instead, we focus on finding solutions together and supporting you through any tricky situations.

We understand that everyone makes mistakes, and that's okay. We see these as opportunities to learn and grow.

When challenges come up, staff are here for you. We'll work with you to:

- **Understand the situation:** We'll listen to your perspective and help you figure out what happened.
- **Find solutions:** Together, we'll brainstorm ways to make things right and prevent similar situations in the future.
- **Offer support:** We'll provide guidance and encouragement to help you through any tough times.

Are
mobile phones
allowed?

We know that many of you have mobile phones and might want to bring them to school. That's okay! But to keep things organised and safe, here's what we ask:

- **Store it safely:** When you're at school, you must keep your mobile (and any other electronics) in the class resource cupboard or office.
- **Use of mobile devices:** Mobile's and electronic devices are only used when travelling to and from school. They are not to be used on site due to safeguarding issues.
- **Be responsible:** We trust you to use your phone responsibly. This means being respectful of others and not using it in ways that distract from learning or are unkind.

Important note: If someone uses their mobile phone irresponsibly, they won't be able to bring it to school anymore.

What will happen
on my first day of
school?

Your first day is all about getting comfortable and making new friends. Here's what you can expect:

- **Warm welcome:** When you arrive, a friendly staff member will be waiting to greet you right at the entrance.
- **School tour:** We will show you around Hill View School, so you'll know where everything is – your classroom, the assembly hall, lunch area, and more.
- **Meet your classmates:** You'll get to meet your new classmates and teacher in your classroom. Everyone's excited to have you join us!
- **Staff introductions:** Throughout the day, you'll also get to meet other teachers and staff members who are here to help you learn and grow.

We want you to feel right at home. If you have any questions or need anything, just ask! Everyone here is happy to help.

Who will meet me
when I arrive at
School?

If you ever feel a little lost at Hill View, don't worry – we're here for you! Here's what you can do:

- **Look for an adult:** Remember, Hill View has lots of staff members. You're never too far away from someone who can help.
- **Just ask:** If you feel comfortable, ask any familiar adult. Hill View School adults will often be wearing a Hill View hoodie or lanyard. They'll be happy to guide you.
- **We're here to help:** Our staff are really good at noticing if someone needs help. If you look a little unsure, they'll come over and ask if you're okay.

Remember there will be lots of adults around site and our learners can be supported around site to get to lunch and other areas of the school.

Will there be
animals?

You've already met our friendly school dog, Jenson! He loves running around and going on walks with learners.

But guess what? Jenson won't be the only animal friend at Hill View School!

We'll also have:

- **Chickens:** You'll get to collect fresh eggs and maybe even see some cute chicks!
- **Small animals:** We'll have some smaller furry friends too, like rabbits or guinea pigs. They love cuddles and playtime!

Soon we will be getting some **Farm animals** and they'll need your help with brushing and feeding!

Caring for animals is a big responsibility, and we'll need your help! You'll learn all about how to keep them happy and healthy, and you'll make some new animal friends along the way.

Who can I talk to if I have a problem?

If you ever have a problem or something is bothering you, there are lots of people here at school who can help.

- **Talk to any adult:** You can talk to any adult at school – your teacher, the TA, office staff, anyone you feel comfortable with. We're all here to listen and support you.
- **Success Team:** We also have a special group called the Success Team. They're here to help you with anything you need and are always around the school, even popping into lessons.
- **We care:** Don't be afraid to speak up! Everyone at school wants you to feel safe and happy. Talking about things can make them feel a whole lot better.

Will there be homework?

We do things a little differently when it comes to homework. We believe that learning happens best when you're feeling relaxed and refreshed. So, instead of sending work home, we make the most of our time together in the classroom.

This means:

- **More time for you:** You'll have plenty of time after school to pursue your hobbies, spend time with family and friends, and just relax.
- **Focused learning at school:** We'll make sure you have all the support and resources you need during the school day to learn and grow.
- **Exciting activities beyond the classroom:** We'll offer lots of fun clubs and activities after school if you want to keep exploring your interests.

Who will meet me when I arrive at School?

A member of your class team will meet you either at your taxi or minibus and as you become more confident they will meet you at your learner entrance.

What do I need to bring to School?

We know that bringing a heavy bag school can be difficult. That's why we provide all the essential resources you'll need for a successful day at Hill View School. From pens and pencils to notebooks and folders.

This means you don't need to remember to bring a lot of kit to school if you don't want to and instead arrive at school feeling light and ready to focus on what really matters.

A Few Helpful Reminders:

- **Pencil Case & Stationery:** If you have a favourite pencil case or special pens and pencils you love to use, feel free to bring them along.
- **Snacks:** We want to make sure you stay fuelled throughout the day. If you bring snacks to school, we can store them safely in the classroom cupboard until you need them.
- **Water Bottles:** We have fresh drinking water available in every classroom, along with cups for you to use. If you prefer to bring your own water bottle, that's perfectly fine too.

Do I need to get changed for PE

At Hill View, we believe that being active and having fun in PE is an important part of school life. To make the most of our PE lessons, we encourage all learners to get changed into their PE kit.

Getting changed for different activities is a great way to build your independence and responsibility. It's a life skill that will help you in many situations, both in and out of school.

If you have PE scheduled for the day, you are welcome to arrive at school already dressed in your PE kit. This can save you time and make your morning routine even easier.

Do we have to wear uniform?

We want you to feel comfortable and be yourself while still showing your part of Hill View School and our team! That's why we've made our school uniform super flexible!

- **Primary:** A cosy Hill View fleece to stay warm.
- **Secondary:** Hill View hoodie.
- **T-shirt choices:** You'll have different Hill View t-shirt designs to choose from.
- **Anything goes on the bottom:** Wear whatever you like on your legs – jogging bottoms, shorts, trousers, skirts, you name it!
- **Shoes in every colour:** You can wear any shoes in any colour.

We just ask a few things to keep you comfy and prepared:

- **Spare clothes:** Keep an extra set of clothes at school in case things get muddy or messy.
- **Wellies and sturdy shoes:** We love spending time outdoors, so wellies or sturdy shoes are great for those muddy days.
- **Warm layers:** Make sure you have some warm clothes to wear outside, even when it's chilly.

How many lessons are there?

There are 5 lessons which are 45 minutes long. Every lesson includes a sensory regulation break at the beginning and end to help you prepare for the next lesson and get you ready to learn.

Where are the toilets?

We have lots of toilets around the school. Any learner can use any of the learner toilets which have one toilet and a sink. For our younger learners staff will support you to visit the toilet if needed.
